

Fitting Your Shadesail Corners

The final corner(s) of the shadesail will most likely seem very tight, this is normal. In order to get the sail close enough to the eyebolt/attachment point you may need some mechanical advantage. The easiest way to do this is to use a lacing which is provided with the sail.

Take the length of light line provided and attach the D-Shackle to the eyebolt. Then pass the line back through the ring of the sail and back through the eyebolt several times. You have just made a simple tackle system which will enable you to easily stretch the corner of the sail up to the shackle or turnbuckle.

Once the turnbuckle has been hooked onto the corner of the sail, remove the lacing and tension the sail using the turnbuckle.
